was no immediate opportunity for you to begin the  
work of the mission, I thought just that you should  
provide for yourselves for a time, as you do from  
the high price of labor could by moderate Application  
8. or 10 per Day. Shortly after your arrival Information  
was received of the loss of the Proyde. In a few weeks  
more of the murder of Tippahke, and every man  
woman, and Child that could be met with in his  
District, by the masters and crews of the different  
whalers who were then on the Coast of that Island.  
These unexpected and unfortunate Events rendered it  
imprudent for you to proceed to New Zealand at that  
time, as we were ignorant what effect these murders might  
have upon the minds of the natives. In a few weeks  
some natives of New Zealand came to Port Jackson  
again, three of these men besides Tuatara I took into  
my own House. A fair opportunity now occurred  
for you to begin the work of the mission by acquiring  
the language, and forming an intimacy with the  
natives. I proposed to assist you one Hour every  
morning in my own study along with a
