 the missions of the British Church Missions Society"

 yourself president &c. — We wish such a Society
 to be in direct and exclusive connection, with us
 at home, so our friends and brethren of the
 (London) Missions Society we wish all success;
 but, for the preservation of perfect good will,
 and for the securing of our own consideration
 and of the Countenance of the Church, we
 find it expedient to act as separate and
 distinct from all other Societies —

On the formation of such a Society
 you are authorized to draw on me to any
 amount (at the Society's House, Salisbury St
 London) not exceeding £500 per annum, so
 long as it shall appear to the Committee here
 that the said sum is well employed, in promoting
 the object of the Society in your parts — we should
 be glad to have a separate account of such part
 of this annual amount granted as may be
 drawn for in order to the establishment and
 support of schools, as we keep that fund separate
