I have furnished Mr Cooper with several copies of Mr Woodd's plans of Religious Instruction which were presented to me by the Society, and Mr Cooper says me to express the pleasure he feels in introducing those plans into the different schools at Sydney which he superintends. Several children at Parramatta have also learned by rote the card of Prayer, and for Sunday schools, & introduced me for which I have presented each with a reward. The Female Orphan at Sydney have not only received instruction from the production of my friend but have also been made partakers of his liberality.

Out of the supplies which I received from the British and Foreign Bible Society, the Naval and Military Bible Society, the Religious Tract Society, the Rev. Basil Woodd, and Mr Geo. Nuttall, I have distributed Bibles Testaments, Religious Books & Tracts amongst the prisoners, guard, passengers, and ship's Company on board the Earl Spencer, to four schools at Parramatta, to a reading library & some schools in New South Wales, and likewise amongst many soldiers and others in the Colony. It is my intention to leave some at Van Diemen's Land as the vessel will touch at this settlement in her way to New Zealand. Some passengers & others on board the
