they were very pleased with and my friend Mr Kendall
told them that he would teach their children to read books
and with all our proposals they received very much pleasure
I collected two boxes of ^{young} fruit trees of various kinds such
as peaches apples Quinces at the Serwent and brought
them over alive and I have given them to Guaterra
and he has planted them - I also brought near three
bushels of wheat and a hundred weight of potatoes
which I have sent ashore to be planted

so that I am obliged to close my letter but I hope
Dear Sir to give you a more satisfactory
