He is well acquainted with the Island and the natives, and can give the Society every Information they may wish to obtain. I beg to refer the Society to Mr. Brunker, as his Testimony may be depended upon. He is one of the Gentlemen who surveyed the Achive, and knows what my Plans are, so far as related to the safe Settlement of the Missionaries on New Zealand. Mr. Brunker will soon after his arrival, return to New South Wales again; probably Master of some vessel. Pray permit the Society may send out any thing they wish. for he is a very careful man.
