you have discharged the present cargo you will then with as little delay as possible sail to the Bay of Islands on the Coast of New Zealand. On your arrival you will open a friendly intercourse with the Natives particularly Duntona, Eora, Howheata, Warohuru and any other chief that may promote the Object of the Voyage.

The main Object of this Voyage is to promote a friendly intercourse with the Natives of New Zealand. You will do all you can to prevent any quarrel between the Natives and the Ship's Company. If Duntona or any other Chief wish to come to Port Jackson you will receive them on board when you finally leave the Island. If they wish to send any of their children to be instructed or a young man or two there you may bring I wish the Natives to be treated with the greatest kindness while you remain there and every thing to be done that can with prudence to gain their confidence. You will inform them that it is my intention to visit them when the vessel returns, and that I wish a chief to come over to Port Jackson in order that I may enter into some arrangements with him for their benefit.

With respect to the articles you will bring back in the vessel, they must depend upon circumstances, I should wish you to bring as much Hemp as you possibly can.
