I must clothe and outfit them but this I think I can do at a trifling expense. The little boys which now come to me are very fond of Mrs. Pandal, they call her their mother.

My organ has not received the least damage in coming. We can sing to it tolerably well. The natives are astonished at the sound. They also observe us at our worship with attention. They seem to have no mode of worship of their own, or to bow the knee to any thing altho' in conversation they make mention of some Deities. They tell me that the God Atua dwells in the Heavens and He is angry with bad men.
