Rev<sup>d</sup> and Dear Sir,

I have received letters from you bearing date  
Dec<sup>r</sup>. 9. 1813. August 18<sup>th</sup>. 1814 and December 10. 1814  
Your letter dated March 18. 1814 and Missionary  
Registers & accompanying it have not reached  
me and I fear must be lost.

My letters and parcels of Mats and  
curiosities which were sent by the Spring of atam  
Captain Bunker have I trust come safe to  
hand. And I hope you will receive letters  
from me bearing date — February last, and  
a case containing letters and curiosities from  
myself and colleagues sent by the Arctic on  
her departure from hence July 11<sup>th</sup> last.

The Silver Watch mentioned in your favor  
of Dec<sup>r</sup>. 10. 1814. I have received safe. On Oct.
