Bay of Islands ¹⁶ 15. March 1815

I have the pleasure to transmit to you
an account of the particular occurrences which have
come within my observation in this settlement since
the 25th of February last which I request you will
forward to England for the information of the
Church Missionary Society.

Our friend Duatera as you will recollect
was taken dangerously ill before you sailed from
hence to Port Jackson, and after your departure his
illness still continuing to increase the attention
