

Monday and Tuesday June 19<sup>th</sup> & 20. Received some strangers & visited us from the other side of the Island and from other parts amongst whom was a Native of the Marquesas, who was acquainted with Mr Cook of Sydney. They brought with them Amoa in abundance, Flax &c and departed well satisfied with their respective bargains having obtained Axes &c.

On Tuesday July 11<sup>th</sup>. Sailed for Botany Bay Port Jackson having obtained a cargo of Spars, Flax &c. The Chief Takooke, Whittoko and some other Natives embarked in her.

I have sent you the Native letters to the Society, Governor Macquarie, Mr Wood, Mr Quirkfall, Mr Hunt, Mr Myers, Mr Marsden, Mr Hapell, Mr Cook, Mr Fleming, Mr Sikes, Mr Dyer, Mr Lattice, Mr Cooper, Mr Nicholas, Mr Keadle, 1 Mat to Mr Wood, 1 to Mr Quirkfall, 1 to Mr Cooper, 1 Book to Mr Peate.

The two Prisoners Rogers & Jony returned to the Settlement glad.
