Settlement sent his canoe with a party in it on purpose to see whether the flag was up or not - just before the canoe arrived the breeze sprang up and spread the flag and they returned very much pleased indeed - and ~~and~~ since that they can see our flag from that Settlement called Corovadick and I believe they keep the Sabbath day as regular as us - I have now removed my family to the bythongue, and Mr Kendall has purposed to have his House built at Jipfomah and remain there, and although it will be very inconvenient for me, I mean to give him all the assistance I can in building his House and school - It was never my intention to separate especially with so few people - But although Mr Kendall has changed his mind I have no doubt but he has done it for the best and I hope our endeavours will be blessed with the same success - I employ ^{several natives} constantly in clearing ground making fences &c I am also teaching some of them to saw Timber - I have not been at much expence with them for cloathing yet, although some European cloathing is necessary for cleanliness - and if your Committee should think proper to appropriate a small portion of coarse cloathing to those domesticated Natives immediately under my instruction as Surgeons and other Workers
