 place - I have got a garden of nearly half an Acre of
 ground fenced in and cultivated - I have planted a part
 of it with Fruit Trees, and the remainder with Indian corn
 Peas, Beans Pumpkins, and other kitchen vegetables
 and I hope with the blessing of God upon our labours
 that our little Settlement will be able to support
 itself in a short time - We have a wide field for labour
 here and if you could strengthen our hands by adding to
 our numbers it would be highly desirable, as the forwarding
 of the great work is the constant endeavour as well
 as the fervent prayer of -
