T. Kendall to J. Pratt, 29 January 1816

Bay of Islands 29 Jan^y 1816

Rev^d and Dear Sir

Mr and M^{rs} Hall and the Children as [sic] this day returned to our Settlement having been plundered of part of their property three days since. M^{rs} Hall has received a severe blow on the face but I am very happy to say she is getting better already. Captain Graham kindly assisted M^r Hall with his boats and men for which he deserves our best thanks. I hope we shall now live together in peace and safety. The natives here are our friends. I am Rev^d & Dear Sir
