Rev<sup>d</sup> and Dear Sir

M<sup>r</sup> and M<sup>rs</sup> Hall and the Children as [sic] this day returned to our Settlement having been plundered of part of their property three days since. M<sup>rs</sup> Hall has received a severe blow on the face but I am very happy to say she is getting better already. Captain Graham kindly assisted M<sup>r</sup> Hall with his boats and men for which he deserves our best thanks. I hope we shall now live together in peace and safety. The natives here are our friends. I am Rev<sup>d</sup> & Dear Sir
