

And after the Propositions were taken, the Judge
 recommended that he should be sent to England,
 but the Governor did not approve of this Step,
 and I have some Reason to think he will
 not be sent Home now tho an order I know
 has been sent for him from the Secretary of
 State - Walker is still at large; and if such
 daring wicked men are not punished I am
 very much afraid the most fatal Consequences
 will follow - such Characters would excite the
 natives to any Acts of Violence against the
 Missionaries in these Islands, and have them
 cut off thro Revenge - I must leave this
 matter to the wisdom of your Committee
 and hope their powerful Influence with
 those in Authority, will be productive of
 some ~~Effectual~~ Good -
