This, however, being matter of opinion, in which I may be Mistaken, I see only One Mode of Redress to which you can resort, which is an Appeal to the Courts of Justice; And if the Letters should be there deemed "Criminal" - the Editor will for his own sake avow the Author - For other Motives than those of Justice, it does not appear reasonable to require a Surrender of the Author's Name; And I would not feel myself acting with that impartiality which my situation demands, and my own disposition dictates, were I to require an exposure in a case where Criminality does not attach in my view of the Publications in Question: -
