

Should the Rev. A. Chads Plan be adopted
 in any degree, and my services considered by those
 concerned at any moment in forming the Colony
 it would be necessary that the permission of the
 Governor of this Colony should be obtained for me
 to go to New Scotland for a quiet time. I have
 little doubt but we shall have another Governor
 and then this point might be settled with him
 Another Chryzomir might be shut out to go
 my duty in the Colony; and on my return
 from New Scotland he might either be
 appointed to officiate at New Scotland, or he
 would easily obtain an appointment in
 this Colony - I have merely mentioned these
 circumstances to you in consequence of Mr. Chads's
 letter - I am ready to render all the service I
 can to promote the object of the Society, and in
 any way that Divine Providence may point
 out - My long Expiration in this Colony might be
 of some service in the first instance -
