I have written a letter to you by Dr. Bromley of the Royal Navy; and have requested him to wait upon you with this open note when he may have a convenient opportunity - I wish you to have a little conversation with him upon my situation in this Colony. From existing circumstances there is some doubt in my mind whether I shall remain long in this Colony. My situation is trying in the extreme. I have no inducement to remain or move in this Settlement, excepting my wish to promote the good of the natives of the South Sea Islands; and for their sakes, I would willingly make great sacrifices - I should consider it one of the happiest days of my life, could I leave
