Captain Thompson is trying to fill up with  
Logs at the Cavallets this time, but I do not think  
the natives can supply his wants the Timber is so  
very far from the shore. I did not think it prudent  
for him to take the Petee up the Bay to Takoo-  
-rooa. The natives do not like your trade after  
such abundant supplies from the Harriet, and  
besides, the greatest part of them are now away  
at the River Thames and other distant parts of  
the Island. I would advise you to send the  
vessel to the Bay Tootoo Kasea on the other side  
of Cape Britt when you want more Spars. Shungke  
and Guuma engage to accompany the Captain  
to that place. When the Gentlemen at Tooko-  
-rooa find you can fill the Petee elsewhere  
they will not be so sassy. Toutattle, Takokee  
or even Wevea say you must not take her  
to any other place. I can tell them you will
