I can not forbear expressing my Astonishment that you should consider yourself insulted by Mr Secretary Campbell in addressing you his letter dated the 3^d Instant on the subject of the Report herein adverted to, his so doing proceeded solely from motives of Humanity and affection for me and my Family, and Solitude for our Safety
