I think you would do very right to encourage Mr King in this work. The natives are often tedious visitants, and when they come, all out door work is generally laid aside, but as spinning can be carried on in the house he would always have an opportunity to employ his time. To spin thread would be much better, than to make native mats. Mr King is in very great want of a suitable building for his other work and also for the above purpose

and he has not hitherto been allowed
my support for the express purpose of
of maintaining those nations whom he
has employed in stone spinning. I trust
Mr Marsden will attend to his needful
