from the heavy Duty put upon it will not
pay for bringing to the Colony. It is my present
intention to employ the Active in procuring
oil at the proper Season, or any other natural
Production of the Sea or Land on the East
Coast of N. Zealand. by which means the
natives all along the Coast will be
visited, and a Communication opened
as far as the East Cape, and a way
prepared for any future Establishments
that the Society may think proper to make.
Should the vessel be fortunate in procuring
oil, she will cover much of her Expenses.
The Civilization of N. Zealand could not be
carried on without a regular Communi-
cation; and therefore she must be for a
time at least employed in the Service.
I have little Doubt, if a Change takes Place in
the Government, but we shall be able to
do something for N. Zealand in the Colony.
