I have received by the *Active* which returned to this place on the 5th Instant. a letter from Mr. Prato dated June 7. 1817 another dated Nov^r. 27. 1817 and a third from you both bearing date March 12. 1818.

I have received the investment containing the articles mentioned in the Invoices bearing Date Oct^r. 29. and Nov^r. 5. 1817. Safe for which I desire to express my sincere thanks.

I now send an order for some more articles of wearing apparel &c. which you will be pleased to procure for me, and forward with the invoice to the Rev^d Mr. Marsden when convenient. My family increases, and we require of course more articles of clothing than formerly. I have sent for nothing but what I think will be useful.
