My Dear Sir,

I have sent Mr. Hindalls
manuscripts by the bearer Mr. V. S. P. who
I am sure will deliver them safe to you
on his arrival - I have also sent by the
same vessel a Packet of Letters by Mr.
Watson Mr. of the Harbour which I
will arrive safe - Should Mr. V. S. P. return
to Miss Colony, which is his present intention
he will take charge of any thing you may
wish to send. I forgot to mention in my
Letters a bale of Sticks which are wanted
for the crew of the Achue, with Cordage
and Canvas. I paid nine Pounds a Bolt
for the best Canvas I purchased for the
Sails. I should wish a supply of Sticks
Canvas and Cordage annually sent out
and charged to my Account for the Achue.
More Articles sometimes cannot be

procured, and they are often very high —
nine pounds a bolt for curcums is immensely
high. but I was compelled to pay the same
or keep the vessel in the Harbour. no doubt,
but Mr. Kendall and the letters will write
by the whalers. They will add well in
April. and had every prospect of doing
well.
