

191 On the 8th To Day we are Sailing with a stiff
Breeze at the rate of 6 knots an hour employed in School

On the 9th We are Sailing much the same to day
at noon we were 120 Miles from Medania employed in
School

And on the 10th Land in sight at 6 in the Morning
and got into the harbor about 3 in the afternoon the
Island of Medania in the evening Mr Butter and myself
went on Shore expecting the Captain would sail in the
Morning to get a few things for our comfort on board
we slept in Medania all night Sailed by 33.

On the 11th To day Morning we heard that the
Captain intended to take in water and fresh Provisions
and not to put in any where else on the Voyage
Cast Anchor in this Morning the two Natives and
Mr Hall went on Shore to Day; and remained ^{there} all
night Mr James Porley

And on the 12th To day Mr Butter and Mr Hall and the
two Natives came on board and in the afternoon Mr Butter
and Mr James Porley and Mr Butter went on Shore for a few
hours as it would be the last time till we come to the end
and returned on Board in the evening

On the 13th Weid Anchor at Noon but little wind
but towards the evening it blew quite fresh so that we
sailed at the rate of 9 knots

Sunday the 14th We had Publick Service on Deck
as usual and Mr Croft read the Prayers he also read
a Sermon the text was taken from 3rd of the 2nd Timothy 16
my soul was Delighted to see so many souls on the
great deep assemble to worship our great creator
we had the Prayers in Mr Halls Cabin in the evening
Mr James Porley is very porley with sickness not able to attend with us
