rough so that it rent 5 sails. After school among the convicts  
this morning a man by the name of Willcock a convict  
stopped Mr Butler and said that he felt himself a grate  
sinner in the sight of God: and wished for some advice respecting  
his soul. employed as usual

And on the 17<sup>th</sup>. Sailing about 9 mts an hour Mrs Hemb is  
but poorly to day employed in school in
