

And on the 31st. The wind continues to blow against us our course is N.E. and we are steering South East - employed in School as usual

On the 1st of June - The wind is much the same. two weeks to Day of foul winds. Employed as the Day past - My soul was greatly refreshed with that sweet promise strengthen ye the weak hands and confirm the feeble knees say to them that are of a fearful heart be strong

And on the 2nd. The wind much the same as the Day past employed as usual

On the 3rd. To Day the wind is somewhat Better employed in School. Toiv and Testence I hope more in there reading and are more attentive

And on the 4th. But little wind and what there is is quite against us the water is getting very low and the Ships Crew begin to complain one pint and a half a Day We humbly pray the Lord to send us a fair wind so that we may reach some land to Day we were 280 miles from Kings Island employed as usual in School

On the 5th. In the Night past the wind came more fair for us: so we hope if it continue we shall be able to make Vencamans land in a few Days we are 350 miles from it today employed as the Day past - My soul was refreshed with that sweet promise in Proverbs they that seek me evil shall find one

Sunday the 6th. Not any wind quite a calm - We had Service on deck Mr Butter read the Prayers and Mr Grop read a Sermon from the 14th ^{ch. pt.} of Jeremiahs ^{vers} in the evening we had Service in Mr Grop's Cabin Mr Butter read a Sermon from the 62nd Psalm ^{vers} 12 - My soul to Day was comforted and refreshed in hearing from his Blessed word his love and his mercy to Poor sinners even to unworthy me the vilest of the vile

On the 7th. The wind somewhat better for us - the Night past one of the Convicts died his name was Painter about 64 years of age he died very Desirous of hearing how he was to be saved - employed in School

And on the 8th. The wind much the same - we are ^{only} 226 miles from the Deservant the land which we are trying to make to get water and fresh provisions. it is in Vencamans lane employed as the day past - The Lord enabled me to rejoice in looking forward to that happy time ~~when~~ when all shall know me from the greatest even unto the least of them
