 we shall prosecute our Voyage without touching  
 any where. We are all thro' every, bracingly  
 & warmly in acting unkindly but we hope we  
 will see her soon, and take our advice and  
 endeavor to learn to read it. I have only time  
 to add. Fair sticks to us & I hope will continue  
 to do so. We have not that delight for Divine  
 things which might have been expected from my  
 last report. - They both join me in affectionate  
 regards to all.
