

Thursday 22 April 1819

Proceeding on our voyage with a moderate breeze right aft. Studding sails set above and aloft — Mr. Kemp better. Had school in the Cabin as usual but none on deck being working day — the residue of the day employed getting up our things out of the hold and drying them being much wet by the late severe weather we have experienced — especially the bedding which was packed in an improper and slovenly manner.

Friday 23 April

The fine NW breeze continues all sail set. I believe we have run 160 miles the last 24 hours — Employed in the school; reading &c — Got up the other two packages of bedding to dry — Many of the missionary stores removed from the fore orlop to the after hold, where we hope they will be kept dry.
Lat 39. 13 S — Long 32. 18 E

Saturday 24 April

Smart breeze which obliged us to shorten sail — went down into the hold to see our things fresh stowed, but the ship rolled so much we were obliged to give over till another day. Had school with Doi and Teberoo — the remainder of the day emp^d. reading and writing — Heavy rain Thunder & lightning
Lat 39. 5 S Long 35. 45 E

Sunday 25 April

Blowing a gale of wind from the NW about 3 o'clock carried away the fore yard, got up a jenny one & set the sail — all hands at work getting a piece of timber out of the Chavis to fit the yard with — Had no service on deck today on account of the inclemency of the weather — and the dead lights being down it was dark as visible in our Cabin. In the evening the gale moderated — Mr. Butler read prayers and a sermon — the text was from 6 Romans — "I will not have dominion over you"
Lat. 39. 6 S — Long — 39. 54 E.

Monday 26 April

Smart gales from the NW — Employed with Doi & Teberoo the New Zealand Language &c — Doi complains with a complaint in his eyes.
Lat. 38. 41 S. Long. 42. 30 E.

Tuesday 27 April

Fresh breezes and cloudy W^t have run 209 miles on our course the last 24 hours — Employed as before. In the afternoon went down into the hold, to examine further into the things which are damaged. found several packages wet. The spinning wheels will in all probability be quite useless by the time they arrive at their destination from bad package and the bedding also, being only put in single wrapping instead of cases.
