Dear Sir I hope you will be so kind as to send this Russell to Windham as soon as you can. remember us to all our friends at the Prisonary house Dear Sir we are all at this time pretty well bless the Lord for it. It is trusting on his promises that I have found quite comfort and I hope will be the comfort and support of my soul to the end of the world. Pray for us.
