 have drawn for any part of her purchase money  
 without your sanction being again obtained,  
 had I not found myself obliged to do this in  
 order to settle some of my pecuniary matters  
 previous to my sailing for N. Zealand -  
 I deem the Vessel and Cargo, if she gets  
 one, will be sufficient security to the Society  
 for any Advances they may make - I have  
 endeavored to express my meaning as well  
 as I can, and hope you will clearly under-  
 stand what my intentions are. I wish now  
 to sell the Active, and to be relieved from so great a  
 responsibility - I will give every personal Assistance  
 in any way in my power to promote the mission.  
 And shall not think any toil too much to forward  
 so great a work. - Mr. Robt. Campbell will  
 manage the concerns of the Society as far as  
 respects the Vessel with great fidelity - and  
 I have seen Mr. Pike, that in a little time  
 we may be able to form our auxiliary  
 Society in N. Zealand: as soon as the  
 present Government is changed, and
