

this traffic in future - I have explained to  
all the neighbouring Chiefs, that the Letters  
must not be taken with, Gunpowder or account  
with muskets and Powder, and if they  
will not supply them with what they want,  
they must return to Port Jackson - none  
of them will hear of the Letters leaving  
them - I think it much more to the  
Honour of Religion, and the good of the Indians  
to give up the mission at the present than  
trade with the natives in these articles.  
I hope you will bring none out with you  
if you do, they will be of no use to you when  
you return, unless you have a sanction from  
the Committee to dispose of them, which  
I think will not be granted - I need add no  
more on this subject, further than to  
assure you that all connection between  
me and you, as far as concerns the mission  
must be at an end, if you entertain any  
Idea of repeating what has been formerly done
