I received your account current yesterday from Mr Campbell which amounts to about £200 Ster^s. I feel it my duty to call upon you to state what your final determination is respecting the mission - The Society will expect me to give, as best some satisfactory Reason for drawing upon them for the above sum - The Sydney Gazettes are regularly sent to the Committee your name will appear as twice advertised for leaving the Colony; and each time a passage has been provided for you. The Committee will think it strange you did not proceed to the place of your destination, more especially when Mr Kendall went to New Zealand - If you do not feel a warm desire to promote the good of the mission
