has prevented me again - I shall now sit down
quietly for the present - I am much relieved
in my own mind; as the storm is now break-
ing - I am very thankful that my way was
hedged up twice - Had I not been on the spot
to have vindicated my own cause; and the
cause of both the Friend & C. M. Societies, the
Enemy would have had great Advantage over
all in the Examinations taken before the
Honourable Commissioner of Enquiry - The
Accusers could then have none to contradict
their Accusations. God will overcome all to the
