 had cost me considerable trouble and expense
 to get them into the country - Their breed was
 very bad - Had they acted properly from the
 first they would have had plenty of milk
 and butter, and a considerable quantity
 of beef by this time, and would not
 have been so dependent upon the natives.
 If the Society could meet with a few Purses,
 or if a few Purviches were settled upon
 the Society's land that would be an excellent
 thing - I think there is little doubt, but they
 might soon maintain themselves, if they
 were industrious - Some measures must
 be adopted to render the missionaries
 independent of the natives - and there is
 none but Agriculture, that can furnish
 them with supplies - The whalers are
 likely to ruin the whole country with
 by
