I am happy to inform
you that Mr. Kendall with Strongee
and his Companion have arrived safe
and well. All in good spirits, and have
been kindly treated by the Master of
the Maker. I am anxious to forward
them to West Greenland as soon as
possible. The Active is in the River
Arctic at the present procuring
oil, and I do not expect her till about
Sep^r. I have some intention of taking
up the West Greenland, a Ship about
100, or 500 Tons to go to Adelphi or
King Penners Account, if the Master
and I can come to Terms, if so I shall
agree with him to take Mr. Kendall
to West Greenland. This Ship can be
ready in a few days. If I can take up
the West Greenland wholly at Penners's
Expense, without rendering the
London Missionary Society with any
