*Samuel Marsden to the CMS Committee at the Bay of Islands*

Sydney June 11<sup>th</sup> 1822

Dear Sirs

I herewith forward to you a Letter which I have felt it my duty to write to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Thomas Kendall— which you will hand over to him when you have read and consider'd it— while those public charges are alled'd against him, and universally believ'd it is not proper that M<sup>r</sup> Kendall should remain connected with the Church Miss[ionar]y Society until he has justified his conduct and prov'd that he is Innocent of those Scandalous Sins with which he is charg'd
