(It is my intention to bring back with
me some of the Children of the
Chiefs to Parramatta for Education -
The Conduct of some of the missionaries
have been so improper, that I think the
Success of the mission, and the existence
of the mission has depended under God
upon the Residence of the natives at
Parramatta, and the Knowledge they
have acquired of civil life while they
remained here. The natives have always
been coming and going to and from New
Zealand to Parramatta, and a greater or
lesser number have always lived with
me - I am under no apprehension myself
for the safety of the missionaries, nor for the
final success of the mission (As I had proposed
the Rev. G. Kendall from his situation as a
missionary until the pleasure of the
Society was known - I thought it would be
