I therefore beg leave unequivocally to state to you that although I shall be ready to embark with my family on board of the Brig Dragon as soon as convenient accommodations are prepared for our reception, yet I shall expect you will previously be answerable for any of my property which may be damaged or lost in consequence of accompanying you and that you will further engage on the part of the Church Missionary Society to pay for the passage of myself and Family to England, and afford us every needful support during our residence in New South Wales.
