The people appear to live in
 amity and peace among themselves
 when under the government of one
 chief. — I saw no quarrelling nor
 domestic broils while I was on
 the Island. — They are kind
 to their women and children,
 I never observed a mark of
 violence on any of them. nor
 did I see a woman struck: &
 the Missionary Settlers informed
 me that they had never seen
 any differences among the
 native people of Pangkeeboo
 during the period they had resided
 there. — I have reason also to
 hold the same opinion generally
 of those of them who inhabit the
 districts on the south side of the
 Bay of Islands. especially when
 connected with each other by
 the ties of blood or being of the
 same tribe and belonging to
 the same village. — I was likewise
 informed
