 sawyers, we found, were gone with them.  
 The report is, that the Natives, in these  
 districts, are going to muster their tribes;  
 and to demand satisfaction from  
 Shunghee for the men whom he shot,  
 in his late attack on the village. Shunghee  
 has a Heppah in the Bay of Islands,  
 about two miles from Raughee-hoo,  
 which he is fortifying, and preparing to  
 receive the enemy.

As these people have no regular establish-  
 ed government, it appears that all crimes  
 are punished, either by an appeal to the  
 sword, or by plundering the offender of his  
 little property and laying waste his  
 potatoe grounds.
