

I saw were the Heads of Four Chiefs whom Shunghee had killed in battle. He also brought with him two Chiefs as prisoners, and many more Heads. Mr. Kendall told me that Shunghee was eleven months on his voyage; and returned eight months ago, with many prisoners of War, who were shared between him and his subordinate Chiefs.

I could not but reflect, with pain and grief and shame, on the crimes of my countrymen; who, by their wanton atrocities, spread war, misery and death, even among poor Heathen Nations, who have never done them the smallest injury.

What an amazing day that will be, when God shall bring to light the hidden things of darkness!

Almost sixteen years have now elapsed,
