that she was a Prisoner of War; and had been taken between the East Cape and the River Thames, by Shunghee's party, and brought to Ranghkehoo; and that her Aunt's name is Heena, a great Queen. I have often heard that Natives, when at Paroamatta, speak of this Woman, as possessing a large territory and numerous subjects; and Mr. Kendall has occasionally mentioned her, in his correspondence with me. This Young Woman informed me that Shunghee attacked their Settlement by surprise. She was taken prisoner in the town; and her Father, Mother and seven sisters, escaped in the country: none of them were killed. The cause of the attack being made on them, was, that her forefathers had killed three persons belonging to Hupah's tribe, and they came to revenge their deaths. This account confirmed what Shunghee had
