 we found an extensive Harbour, and saw the Heads
~~sent~~ at the distance of about 5 leagues - At Manukou
 three Brothers chiefs were named Howhow, Howcarud,
 Jettarvaugh they carry on an extensive cultivation
 of Potatoes and possess large Tracts of Land on the
 Wyteematta, Wyekotta and Superos Howhow I was
 acquainted with, as he had accompanied me from
 Mayoca to Superos, when I visited that district the first time
 at that time, furnished me with a canoe & servants,
 and attended the whole time till I returned again
 to the River Thames and joined the Commodore
 I made him a present of ^{few} Edge Tools which he
 he highly valued, and promised in return
 he would send me Mats for the Bay of Islands
 as soon as he could procure any - I did not consi-
 der him indebted to me, but rather I was indebted
 to him, and therefore had no Reason to place any
 confidence in his promise - When we first saw
 Howhow was at ^{his} Farm two or three miles distant -
 A messenger was sent for him immediately - on his
