

another new station - After we had met the Chief
and his People and determined upon the Ground
where the Settlement was to be formed, we gave
Directions to the natives, to erect a temporary
Building for Mr. S. Muller and his wife, and they
should immediately ^{come} and live amongst
them as soon as it was ready - we afterwards
returned to Kungsee-hoo about 12 miles distant
where we arrived about sunset.

In the Evening I called a special ^{Committee} meeting, where
all the missionaries were present excepting Mr.
^{Committee} Mr. Gull, who was absent on some other duty -
^{Deliberation} we did not ~~did not~~ close our proceeding until
about midnight - At this Committee the
Resolutions of the Society were brought
under consideration a second time; and
the respective Duties were arranged, and
some other concerns connected with the mission
when the Committee was adjourned to another
Day -

Dec 12th This morning we procured what boards &
other squared Timber we could from Mr. Gull
for the Purpose of erecting a temporary Building
for the Reception of the Rev. G. Williams and
his baggage & stores at Kigsee in order
that all his Goods might be landed as soon
as possible from the Transporter - we
hired a large war canoe to take the boards
& to Mr. Williams station about nine
miles distant on the South side of the
Harbour - we then proceeded on board the
