

Wewee-puk was near Shunghee - he called aloud
 for him to succor him, when the man who
 knocked Shunghee down was instantly killed.
 Enak-kee also fired a pistol at Shunghee, one
 of them which Shunghee had given him
 at Fort Jackson, but without effect - Enak-kee
 then rushed forward with his bayonet fixed to
 stab Shunghee while on the ground, when
 the officers of Shunghee's force saw that
 instant fired and shot - Enak-kee, when he fell
 Wewee-puk was speared at the same time
 thro' the arm by one of Enak-kee's men -
 Shunghee when as soon as he recovered
 from the blow he had received ordered the
 Village to be immediately set on fire which
 was crowded with Enak-kee's people - the battle
 then became general - in the midst of the contest
 Wewee-puk, was anxious to save as many of
 the children of the Chiefs as he possibly could,
 and carried 25 of the field to a place of safety
 tho' he himself was speared - ~~and~~ ¹⁰ of
 these he restored to their friends before he left
 the shores; and 15 he brought with him to
 the Bay of Islands as Prisoners of war,
 but his savior returned them all - As soon
 as the battle became general Shunghee, and
 he was sure of victory, ~~he~~ ^{he} ordered all
 Enak-kee's Auxiliaries to lay down their
 arms, and fly into the woods, as he
 only wished to destroy the strength of
