Dear Sir

Mr. Balington

I have just seen Lord Othello
most who agrees to carry out
Mr. Kendall & his wife & five
children to New South Wales,
giving them ship-room gratis, &
also considering Kendall as to be
read on shipboard & afterwards
to have the usual rations on
shore after his arrival as long
as is usual in ^{similar} the cases of
those who go to the Settlements, as
Kendall is to be. In case his
wife is qualified to be a school-
mistress there, & will undertake
responsibility
~~that she will~~ she too will have
rations on shipboard & on shore,

like her husband. In short I understood
that they will be no expense to the
No 69 Society. - However it is a direct stipu-
lulation made by ^{July 22nd 1812} Dr. Bethune,
that Mr. Plender ^{will just go. not to be} shall remain in
New South Wales at least three
years. After that time he may
use his discretion as to moving
to New Zealand. ~~At least three~~

It appeared to Mr. W. & myself,
that this stipulation was reason-
able. - We have blessed the
Mission Socy. to pay for the food
of the children (& of the wife also
if she is not to be a schoolmistress)
so that Government is to be put
to no expense on this account either
on the board or on shore. And Dr.
Bethune says, that the payment
~~for~~ for this food by the Society
shall be at the same rate as if
it were by Government, if the rules
of the service will admit of this
without introducing an unnecessary
disturbance; - We explained to his

good that ~~one~~ ^{one} great object in view
was to instruct natives of ~~the~~ New
Zealand, & that therefore Mr K
might not improbably in time
remove the tax.
