I am honoured with your letter respecting Mr Kendall & as I shall not be in town at present, I as Mr Wilberforce is much better known to Lord Bathurst than I am, I send it to Mr W. — However I would just remark, that in our conversation with Lord Bathurst there was no promise of Actions for the Mr Kendall or Mrs H. Nor 3 years but only of such ^{actions & other} advantages as were usual in like cases & a grant of Land as a settler, but not a promise of stocking the Land but something ^{implied if not directly said} was ~~said~~ by H. B. against stocking it.
