I am honoured with your letter respecting Mr Kendall & as I shall not be in London at present, & as Mr Wilberforce is much better known to Lord Bathurst than I am, I send it to Mr W. — However I would just remark, that in our conversation with Lord Bathurst there was no promise of Actions to the Mr Kendall or Mrs H. for 3 years but only of such <sup>actions & other</sup> advantages as were usual in like cases & a grant of Land as a Settler, but not a promise of stocking the Land but something <sup>implied if not directly said</sup> was ~~said~~ by H. B. against stocking it.
