Annum to be paid into the funds of your Society, out of the income of some property which I have in Yorkshire. — All that I shall want from you, with respect to pecuniary matters, will be, wherewithal to get a little food and raiment. I have no secular object in view.

I do love the Lord Jesus Christ, because He hath loved me with an everlasting love, and with loving kindness hath He drawn me — And I am anxious that the Heathen should love Him also; and I am willing to leave a country that I love, and do what I can, looking to
